## Mini Virtual Program - Lynn Koolish - May 14, 2022

- Assorted pieces of fabrics, minimum size about 3" x 6", up to as large as you want. Have enough to cover a 20" x 26" surface (avoid batiks and other tightly woven fabrics).
- Batting or backing fabric, size is up to you but 20" x 26" is a good starting size.
- #8 Perle cotton, embroidery floss, or sashiko thread in your choice of color(s).
- A large-eye, sharp needle such as an embroidery needle, size 4 crewel, or sashiko needle.
- Fabric scissors or a rotary cutter and mat
- Straight pins
- If you have appliqué glue or a regular glue stick, have it handy to temporarily hold things together
- Thimble (optional, but can be helpful)

<sup>\*</sup> You can also chose to make a Japanese knot bag (a pattern will be provided), so you might need a different size of batting or backing fabric depending on the size bag you want to make.
