

Improv Applique

From the tools of the trade to basting to final stitches, this class will cover hand applique basics with a big twist – we're doing it improvisationally! Looking for inspiration, cutting shapes, and block prep are part of the class. This is definitely not the applique you are used to. Portability and great design make applique a skill worth learning. Settle in for some slow stitching.

Fabric Selection

2 contrasting fat quarters or set of charms (5" precuts)

Supplies

Coordinating Thread (or neutral DecoBob or silk thread)

Contrasting Thread

Pen

Pins

Gold Eye Applique Needles (No 12) (Suggested) or similar

Fabric Scissors, Paper Scissors, and small appliqué scissors

Rotary Cutter and Cutting Mat with 12 ½" x 12 ½" ruler (or similar)

Needle Threader

Reading or magnifying glasses, if you wear them

Thimble for middle finger of your dominant hand recommended
