



# Molehills Quilt

## Supply List

I'm looking forward to meeting all of you for our Molehills Quilt class. We will do cutting in class as I will show you techniques for cutting curved templates freehand and how best to lay out your templates.

The Molehills pattern includes baby through king sized layouts and you can start any size that you would like. I encourage people to make a baby or lap sized quilt in class since these are the only two sizes that are possible to finish in class. But, if you choose to go for a larger sized quilt you will get a lot done and will go home confident enough in the technique to be able to finish your quilt easily.

### Pre-Work

Your pre-work before class is just to select fabric and dream about your layout. This is the time to raid your stash or maybe to enhance it with a few extra yards. It is much better to bring too much fabric than to not have enough for this class since the top arcs to the fans are really large and can swallow up a lot of fabric. Also too much fabric allows for freedom to be able to play more with layouts. The pieced arcs are also great for using scraps. Important: The half yards required in the supply list are important due to the size of the top two arcs of the fans.

### Layout

There are almost unlimited layout options available for this quilt. On the next few pages you'll find a couple photos that will hopefully help to spark your imagination. You can also search the hashtag #molehillsquilt on Instagram for other fun ideas. Start to pull your fabric based upon what kind of layout you are leaning towards. And, we will discuss layouts more in class as well.

# Supplies for Class

## Pattern:

Molehills Quilt Pattern (Bring your copy or it will be on sale in class)

## Fabric:

Baby sized – A variety of ½ yard cuts to equal four yards

Throw sized – A variety of ½ yard cuts to equal eight yards

## Supplies:

Rotary Cutter

Paper Scissors (or Paper Rotary Cutter)

Fabric Scissors

Cutting Mat

Small Ruler for Rotary Cutter

Flat Head Straight Pins

Erasable Fabric Marker (Air or Water)

Neutral Thread for Piecing

Scotch Tape

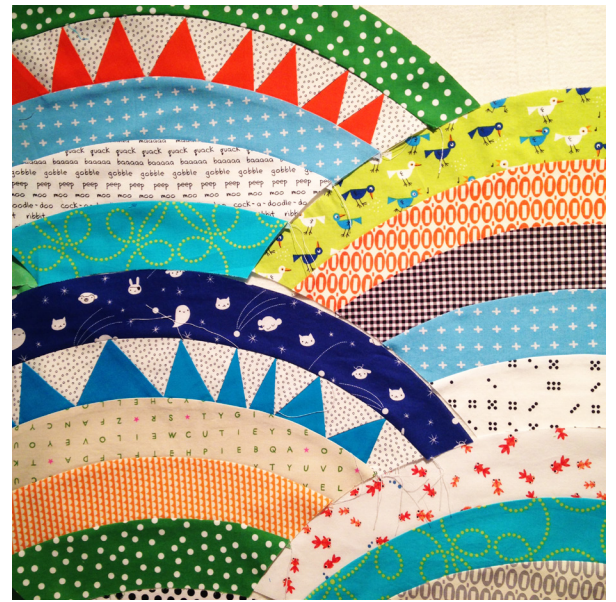
