Fabric Selection

Scraps in multiple colours (where pieces are at least 6" long, width optional).

OR

Fat quarter set (where contrast in colour and value are evident)

*It is good to have choices when it comes time to play.

Supplies

- Pen & Paper for notes and sketching
- Basic quilting/sewing knowledge
- Sewing Machine
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter, and scissors
- Plastic rulers – 1 square, minimum 12.5" by 12.5", and one long one (optional)
- Seam ripper and bobbins
- Thread for piecing
- Scissors
- Chocolate and/or candy are highly recommended
